

Ushers

An Usher's primary duties and responsibilities include greeting and welcoming parishioners as they enter the church, helping them to find seats, and taking up the collection.

Altar Guild

These parishioners are responsible for the care, laundering and ironing of the linens.

Polishers

Polishers help to enhance the beauty of the church by maintaining and shining the brass and other precious metals.

Sacristan

A sacristan is in charge of care of the sacristy, the upkeep of the sacred vessels, the church, and their contents. The Sacristan is responsible for set up before and after each Mass.

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS

The Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) performs a great service to the Church, by distributing Holy Communion to God's people on those occasions where there are an insufficient number of priests and deacons to distribute Holy Communion to the people present at the Mass, and to the homebound. It is an honor and a privilege to serve the Church in this capacity, and requires careful preparation on the part of the EMHC.

Lectors

A lector is the person who proclaims the first or second reading at Mass. This person also may lead the Psalm (in the absence of a cantor) and the Prayers of the Faithful at Mass (in the absence of the deacon). A lector must have a desire to minister in this capacity at the Mass.
